

Permissions Related to Copyrighted Materials

The following are a set of guidelines for those interested in permission to reproduce materials from *Psychological Reports* or *Perceptual and Motor Skills*.

Permissions

Explicit written permission from Ammons Scientific, Ltd. is required before any reproduction of any materials published by Southern Universities Press; Behavioral Engineering Associates, LLC; or Ammons Scientific, Ltd. All requests may be made to:

We may require permission from the author(s) of the articles in question whenever possible. We do hold the copyrights, but wish always to have the author in mind when various uses are requested. We may require a royalty if there is any commercial use at all. Other restrictions may apply as described in this document.

Citations

In all cases, when permission has been granted for reproduction of materials, each reproduced article or selection must include a full citation on the top of the first page, using the format:

Print Versions

Typical permissions can be obtained through the Copyright Clearance Center.

Single Copies

These may be made by anyone under the Fair Use Doctrine. Written permission is not required in these cases. However, making copies that substantially replace a subscription or back issue of the Journals is not permitted.

Multiple Copies

We allow multiple copies to be made by researchers who wish to file them in more than one office, for those who wish to use copies in an academic course of limited duration and size (as handouts or to place on file at a library reading room), or similar uses. Please write for permission.

Making copies as part of a commercially available packet requires special permission. If there is a monetary exchange of any kind for packets that include materials from these journals, royalties may be due. This includes packets that are sold to students for more than the minimal costs of reproduction—copies made available to participants in seminars, lecture series, and so forth. Permission is required and small royalties may be charged.

Reprinted Articles

Requests may be made to the journals for formally reprinted articles. This is only reasonable for larger printings of long articles or monographs. Please request a quote. Electronic Versions

Typical permissions can be obtained through the Copyright Clearance Center.

Single Articles

Authors may place copies of the abstracts, titles, and names of authors on the Internet, a personal web site, or networked computer. Full text electronic versions are not permitted except on limited-access sites for academic classes at universities. Permission is required for such use; electronic versions must be destroyed when the class ends, unless the original request indicates that the class will be offered multiple times.

Multiple Articles

Allowed uses are similar to those listed above for single articles. Permission is required. Please list full citations, how long the materials would be available on the limited-access site, and whether the materials will be needed for more than one semester. Permission will not be granted for reproduction that substantially replaces a subscription to either Journal.

Published Tests

Tests that are part of published articles in these Journals may not be reproduced electronically without permission. In general, we also require that the author's permission be granted for the particular use. Any permission will require that the Internet or web site be limited-access and available only to properly trained professionals. Royalties may be assessed.

Psychological Test Specialists

No tests available from Psychological Test Specialists may be reproduced or distributed electronically.
